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APPLICATION DETAILS FOR SEMESTER ABROAD

Language requirements: B2 level in English (European Framework).

Deadlines: Fall: 1st June 2024 / Spring: 1st November 2024 / Summer: 1st March 2025.

Application documents:

- ID picture
- · Copy of Passport (or ID for British citizens)
- CV
- Transcripts of records of higher education
- · Language certificate of English from home school/university

Acceptance: An official acceptance letter will be sent by email.

OTHER USEFUL DETAILS

Accommodation: OELS assists students in finding accommodation. However, we do not offer student housing. Our housing guide is available online once admission is confirmed.

Health insurance: Students from the EU and EEA member states should apply for an EHIC before coming to London. This card will allow them to get emergency treatment from the National Health Services (NHS) in the UK. We strongly advise them to subscribe to an additional private health insurance, which is mandatory for international students (non-EU/EEA).

Visa requirements: Students from the European Economic Area (EEA), Switzerland or some countries of the Commonwealth*, do NOT need a visa to study at OELS for up to 6 months. However, they MUST have a passport to travel to the UK. Their passport must be valid for the whole of their stay in the UK. International students (non-EEA or non- Switzerland) MUST apply for a Standard Visitor Visa to study at OELS for up to 6 months. It takes 3 months to obtain such a visa. We cannot provide work permits.

Attendance: Attendance to all classes and events is mandatory unless specified otherwise.

Grading system:
